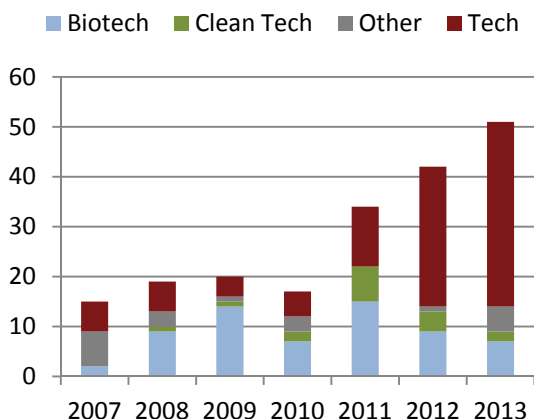
St. Louis Startup & Capital Report 2014

Executive Summary

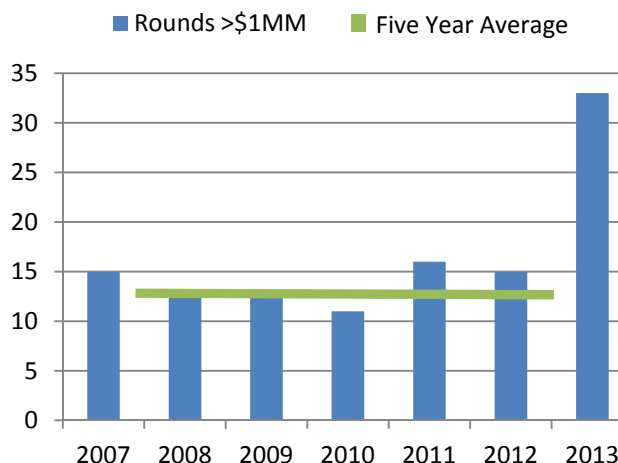
The 2013 calendar year was filled with examples demonstrating unprecedented growth and strength of the regional ecosystem for tech-based startups.

- St. Louis regional startups raised more than \$380 MM in 2013, more than a six-fold increase over 2012 figures.
- At least 33 companies in the St. Louis region raised over \$1 MM in 2013, with a “stripped mean” average raise of over \$5.6 MM.
- The number of investment rounds >\$1 MM in STL in 2013 was double the previous 5 year running average.
- Another 42+ startups raised equity investments totaling less than \$1 MM.
- The pipeline continues to fill as another 50+ new startups popped up in 2013 that weren’t otherwise on our radar; thirty-seven of these new startups were in Tech, continuing the trend which is counter-intuitive for a region with deep research base and support system in Life Sciences.
- Of the 236 companies that have achieved a modicum of startup success since 2006, a remarkable 85%, or 200, are still in business, and are likely now seeking capital investments.
- The one public entity participant, the Missouri Technology Corporation’s IDEA Funds, has closed on projects totaling \$12MM Statewide and saw three exits in 2013 for nearly 3X return.

Attracting Series A Capital



Startups and Capital in St. Louis

The goal of this report is to provide accurate and thorough primary research findings about the startup community in St. Louis with data that illustrates recent historical and developing trends. Our focus is on the pipeline of companies and their equity capital transactions (within the MSA). We made no attempt to report on the availability of debt financing or self-financed startups; those types of funding sources are critical to the vibrancy of the St. Louis region, but that information is not in the scope of this report.

In order to gather accurate and consistent data about companies and their ability to raise outside equity financing, we utilize a classification system previously created to sort companies that may be “venture-backable” and affirms “startup” status; consequently, for this report, a company is considered a startup if, and listed in the first (vintage) year when, it falls into one or more of these categories:

- Accelerator investment (i.e. BioGenerator, Nidus Partners or Capital Innovators).
- Outside Equity Funding (e.g. angel groups, venture firms)
- Incubator client (e.g. T-Rex, Helix, Center for Emerging Technology)
- University-license, granted a local firm with fewer than 200 employees
- SBIR Phase I or II awardee
- Winner of a business plan competition (St. Louis Startup Challenge, WUSTL, Arch Grants)
- Presenter at InvestMidwest, not previously listed
- Other:
 - High-tech, equity-backed firm that have relocated or are new-to-market
 - Self-financed firm within the high-tech NAIC & revenues exceeding \$100K
 - Joint-venture or spin-off of major corporation; in development stage with capitalization

Transactional funding data is updated and annually refined using records provided by Arch Angels, Arch Grants, BioGenerator, Capital Innovators, SixThirty FinTech Accelerator, Billiken Angel Network, Cultivation Capital, publically available SBIR data, Invest Midwest, and SEC Form D filings. This investor cooperation, in addition to public filings, lead to a series of “spot-checks” with active local private investors and serial entrepreneurs to add missing companies. A complete listing of the companies in the “startup database” is provided in the appendix.

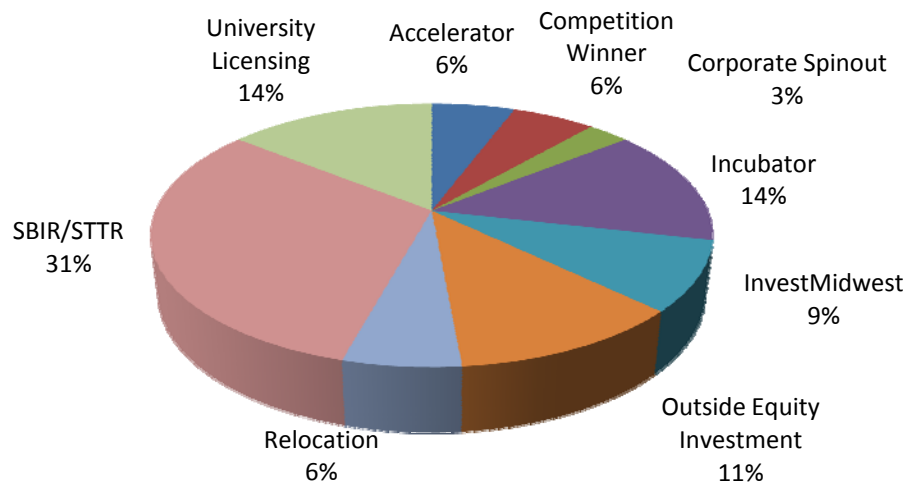
The ability to classify and monitor venture-backable companies allows groups like the Regional Chamber to more accurately track and support startup development. This standardized definition also enables concrete measurement and statistical analysis of the market and longitudinal program impact. Additionally, the information can be used to leverage new start-up resources, investments, and policy that support regional entrepreneurial growth.

It is important to note that the equity capital data that informs this analysis is limited to companies and investors that are willing to disclose data publicly to the media or privately to the researchers. This database continues to be maintained by the St. Louis Regional Chamber, and any additions or corrections to the information are welcomed and encouraged.

The Pipeline Results of the St. Louis Startup Research

While many active startups achieved their startup status in “vintage years” as early as 1998, 2006 was a benchmarking year and it was a good year, with 35 companies attaining a requisite milestone; more than 20 of which were from the biotech industry. This strong year for startup achievement was helped in part by the nascent, but fully functioning, Arch Angels organization, two life sciences incubators, and a robust NIH SBIR Award program.

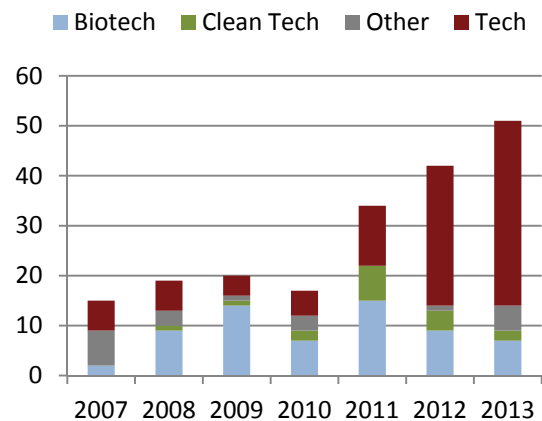
Initial Event to Cause Startup Status Vintage 2006, Total of 35



After a drop in the number of companies reaching “startup” status through the Great Recession, in 2011 pipeline activity returned to pre-recession levels with 34 new startups recognized in the data set. The growth of startups since then has been steadily increasing, with 42 new startups in 2012 and 52 in 2013. These past two years have seen roughly a 25% year-over-year growth in the number of new startups.

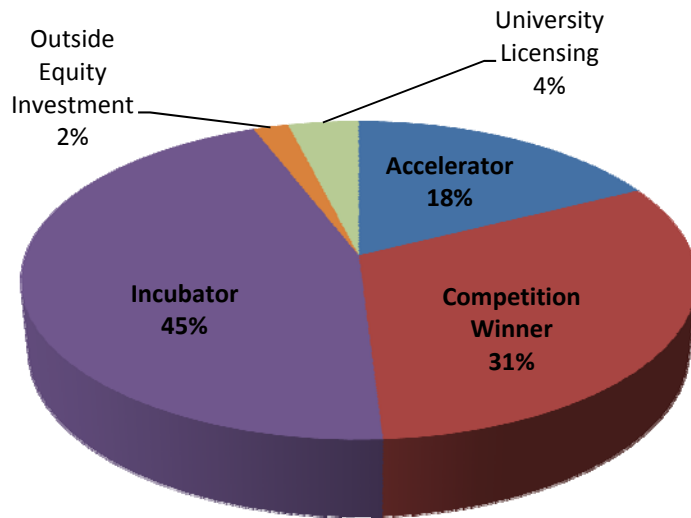
Why such growth? BioGenerator launched an accelerator program in 2010 which impacted positively the number of early-stage startups receiving capital and EIR support. Prior to that, life science companies in our data usually achieved startup status through a university licensing deal or an SBIR award, both with long commercialization horizons. Another propellant in the St. Louis community has been the angels groups, particularly the Arch Angels, which have funded much of the Seed stage life science startup growth. With one of the nation’s highest investment-per-company averages, the Arch Angels have deployed more than \$40 million.

New Startups by Industry



The launch of the Capital Innovators IT accelerator, in 2011, began another type of contributor to the “net new” startups to the ecosystem. This new regional resource has bolstered the IT sector over the last two years. Capital Innovators makes 5/6 tech deals of fifty-thousand dollar per semester, two semesters annually.

Another contributor has been Arch Grants’ launch in 2012, funding another 15 companies at \$50k per year. Consequently, the region ended the vintage year 2012 with the largest number of new companies to reach startup status on record.

In 2013, SixThirty, a financial industry-specific accelerator, started and continues to make \$100,000 equity investments into each new finserve startup – attracting firms to relocate from the UK, NY, and CA.

Lastly, an incubator and focal point of the startup community, T-REX, was recognized - with 80 tenants - as the

fastest growing technology-based incubator in the US.

And while the rise of accelerator programs like BioGenerator’s Spark program, Capital Innovators, and SixThirty, coupled with the impact of Arch Grants non-dilutive grants, have created many more quality startups than ever before, the sense of momentum and sustainability is most palpable when one visits the incubators like T-REX which have created a physical nexus and co-location for investors, startups, and EIR programs.

The Funding Results of the St. Louis Startup Research

Pre-Seed Accelerator Programs like BioGenerator, Nidus Partners, and Capital Innovators, as well as business plan competitions like Arch Grants and the Olin Cup, have accounted for over 37% of companies reaching event startup status since 2006, and have been a catalyst in the Pre-Seed Stage funding category. In turn, this high percentage has created a “startup bulge” at the earliest stages of funding has created a long list of companies that will be seeking Seed Rounds of capital within 18 months of their Pre-Seed investment.

This extraordinary increase in demand has put pressure on the limited sources of Seed capital in the regional economy. In St. Louis, the primary sources for Seed capital have been the Arch Angels and other accredited investors, Cultivation Capital, and in limited cases, the life science venture funds, which will co-invest in early rounds with angels. This Seed (pre-Series A) stage of the funding continuum is perceived to be considerably under-funded.

However, follow-on capital rounds of \$1 million or more have increased surprisingly well as outside capital has stepped in where the local firms have not kept pace with the large number of deals moving through (and projected to move out from) the Seed stage funding parameters.

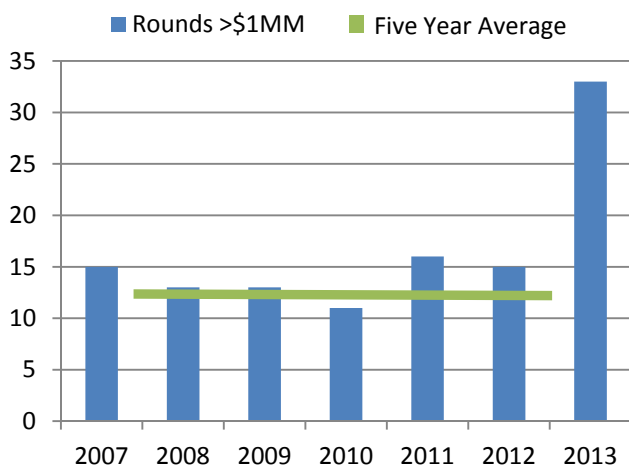

It's at these inflection points - Series A Venture capital investment - where the economic impact is most pronounced. These larger equity investments enable entrepreneurs to take a product to

market, to scale the hiring of employees, or to shift to the mass production of goods or services.

Attracting Series A Capital



While the total dollar amounts of Series A Venture capital rounds invested in local startups has precipitously grown from 2012 to 2013, demonstrating a greater than 600% increase, most of these rounds were lead by investors outside of the St. Louis region. It is commonly held belief that for the pipeline of promising startups to succeed and for the St. Louis region to retain the economic impact, more capital must be under management locally or otherwise ensure that relocation will not be a requirement of continued capital formation.

Afterword: The Regional Chamber and its partners in the AccelerateSTL consortium are working cooperatively to bring new capital investment into play. A five year, \$100 MM Initiative was declared in 2013 to ensure that entrepreneurs will have access to the capital, resources and entrepreneurs-in-residence necessary to make them successful and for the St. Louis region to be a top ten city for venture capital investment per capita.
